FACILITIES

The cost of room, food, gratuities, and tool upkeep at Wildacres is an average of \$600 per person for the six nights. This includes a tool fund donation as well as the additional expense for private rooms for the instructors, the \$5 per person lapidary fees. The facilities at Wildacres are remote and rustic, allowing you to concentrate on the project at hand, and camaraderie of your fellow students, as well as the relaxed evenings time to get to know the instructors personally.
